What is grooming?

The deliberate act of bringing a child into a sexual, political or racial ideology, practice, cult or lifestyle without knowledge or consent of his or her parents for the aim of isolating them from their family so the external party can abuse and manipulate them.

What is a “groomer”?

Groomers can be teachers, sports trainers, counselors, neighbors, church leaders or relatives who secretly engage a minor in obscenity, vulgarity, pornography or sexually-explicit conversations or who lead children to question their identity as a boy or girl.

Groomers harm the emotional, physical, spiritual and psychological health and safety of children.

What does grooming do to kids?

Grooming strips away a child’s natural protective personal and emotional boundaries, making them vulnerable to sexual exploitation. In schools, the sexual content of sexuality education and obscene and vulgar reading materials serve the same grooming purpose as criminal sexual predators luring minors into sexual activity or sexual assault. The FBI’s definition of grooming for sexual abuse:

Sexual predators “groom” children with pornographic images and explicit sexual instruction to remove natural defenses.

Gender grooming psychologically destabilizes children by undermining their identity, teaching them they should doubt and possibly reject their own physical nature.

Examples of Grooming:

Comprehensive Sex Education (CSE)

- Normalizing the viewing of graphic nudity and sexual activity; providing vulgar reading materials.
- Using curriculum as “how to” guides for every kind of sexual behavior and activity including oral and anal sex; encouraging masturbation even at the elementary level.
- Teaching sexual “consent” skills, rather than teaching “refusal skills.”
- Teaching young people they have a right to early sexual exploration and pleasure.

“Queering the Curriculum”

- Intentionally making obscene, pornographic, and vulgar books available in school libraries and using them for class assignments.
- Forcing students to use assumed identity pronouns.
- Promoting and elevating LGBTQ+ school pictures and programs and incorporating them into the curriculum.

Big Tech



Social media is filled with predators, chat rooms and ‘influencers.’

Movies, cartoons, music, and video games are portraying sexually curious teens, LGBTQ relationships, and innuendo.

TV ads for major sports events include LGBTQ characters and hyper-sexualized half-time shows. Major sports teams promote and sell LGBTQ-themed events and sell LGBTQ merchandise.

What is the Truth?

Dr. Miram Grossman: a child, adolescent, and adult psychiatrist, and author of *Unprotected* and *You’re teaching my child WHAT?* explains:

“Adults have to teach children biological truths that could save their lives.”

“Every organ in the body is actually male or female, because every cell,” with the exception of red blood cells, “is imprinted with male or female because of the chromosomes,” meaning, biological gender is innate and immutable.

Anything else is science fiction.

Children are targets for groomers. The consequences are life changing and irreversible.

What can you do?

1. Assess what your child is consuming online and course correct where needed.
2. Assess what they are reading.
3. Have serious and age-appropriate conversations about why they must guard their hearts and minds; why you are able to help them.
4. Affirm the intrinsic value of their created bodies and minds. They are not sexual playgrounds, but someone of infinite worth.
5. Children need only a small amount of biologically based information to keep them safe from being victimized. Good touch/bad touch is still a very safe and accurate place to start.
6. Teach your family’s beliefs and why they matter.
7. Teach your children to never agree to secrets.

Understand that schools will not self-correct. You may have to find educational alternatives.
