I am so happy to let you know that moments ago Minnesota Governor Mark Dayton signed an anti-bullying bill into law — a bill GLSEN has championed for a decade — that explicitly prohibits bullying based on sexual orientation, gender identity and gender expression, along with other characteristics most often targeted for bullying.

Minnesota is now the 16th state plus Washington, DC to enact an LGBT-inclusive anti-bullying law.
